1. View extended hours quotes available 7:00 am into market open, and until 8:00 pm after market close
2. Take action: *trade, add to watch list, set an alert, see your position details, launch screeners, or open the option chain*
3. Click through the navigation options for research tools and data, or choose View All to see everything in a one page view
4. Review detailed quote information including P/E ratio, dividend info, and more
5. Large summary chart for a clear and quick look into the security's history. Use Chart+ for advanced charting features and to save layouts
6. Dedicated space created for short interest data

1. Use the new advanced chart via the Chart+ tab
2. View in table mode and download including indicators you added
3. Save your default layout and additional layouts you prefer
4. Choose your display style, turn on extended hours or dual axis when comparing
5. Search and add your favorite indicators
6. Select technical patterns and events including support and resistance
7. Manage your saved layouts
8. Select either axis to scale them. Zoom using your mouse wheel, or pinch and zoom on a touchscreen
9. Select the indicator panel and expand it to have more working room
10. Use custom date selector to pin-point desired timeframes
